

## Accessing Programs on your Chromebook After First Login

Opening your Chromebook should automatically turn it on. Since you've already logged in before, you should see your name and a line for your password. Type your password (ex: fcs12345) and press Enter. The Google Chrome browser will open and display the FCPS Single Sign On (SSO) page. If you do not see the FCPS Single Sign On page, you can find it in the FCPS Bookmarks button on your bookmarks bar in the upper left corner.

There are two ways of logging onto the FCPS Single Sign On (SSO):



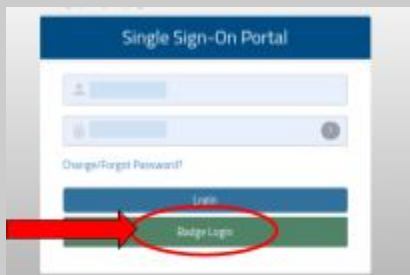
**Type** your:

username (ex: cdembeck982)

and

password (ex: fcs12345)

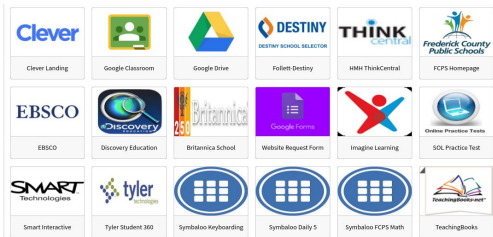
**OR**



IF you have a QR Code Login Badge provided by your teacher, you can simply **scan** it.

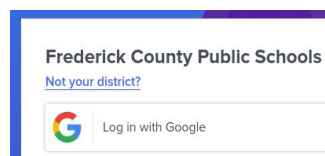
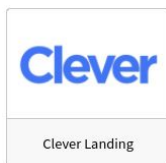
Click the green Badge Login button. When the camera opens, hold your QR Code in front of the camera.

NOTE: The first time you use your QR Code you may be asked to ALLOW camera access. You may have to click the green Badge Login button again to scan.



The FCPS SSO page will open with icons for programs you might use this year including: **HMH (IntoReading), Think Central (GoMath), and Clever.**

**Google Classroom** can be accessed from the SSO portal, the Google Classroom app, or the icon on the bookmarks bar if it has been bookmarked.



Please click the Clever icon, then the "rainbow G" Log in with Google button. You should see your Google account listed. Click your name!

Now you should see icons for programs you will use this year. At the end of the Omnibox (URL address) is a star icon. Click the star, then Done, to bookmark Clever to the bookmarks bar. The next time you open Google Chrome, you can click the Clever icon from the bookmarks bar!
